Carlos Bernardo O. Abad Santos is Assistant Secretary for Policy and Planning of the National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA) of the Philippines. He was previously the Director of Governance Staff under the same office. As Assistant Secretary, he has oversight and supervision on planning and policy formulation of the following Sector Staffs: (a) Governance, (b) Macroeconomy, (c) Social Development, and (d) Trade, Services and Industry.

Previous to his appointment in NEDA on April 2014, Assistant Secretary Abad Santos has had 25 year experience in the area of rural development in both public and private sector. He was Executive Director and Senior Research Fellow of the Asia-Pacific Policy Center (APPC) from 2005 to 2013, where he spearheaded or collaborated on studies relating to poverty, agribusiness development, local governance and agrarian reform. He likewise worked as independent consultant for several institutions including the Asian Development Bank, the World Bank, Southeast Asian Regional Centre for Graduate Study and Research in Agriculture, and Save the Children Federation, Inc. He worked in the Department of Agrarian Reform from October 1987 as Executive Assistant to June 2004 as Director III.

Mr. Abad Santos has a Masters in Economics from the University of the Philippines-School of Economics, and a Diploma in Economic Development Planning from the Instituto di Studi per lo Sviluppo Economico.
